Beaufort Commerce Park — Beaufort, SC

The Beaufort Commerce Park is a 199 acre industrial park located in the City of Beaufort, 5 minutes from the Marine Corps Air Station, 25 minutes from Interstate-95, 45 minutes from Savannah and 1 hour and 30 minutes from Charleston. The park is located in a Federal Opportunity Zone and eligible for New Market Tax Credits. Surrounding industry include Geismar North America, Flint Group Inc., Harris Pillow Supply, and Materials Research Group. 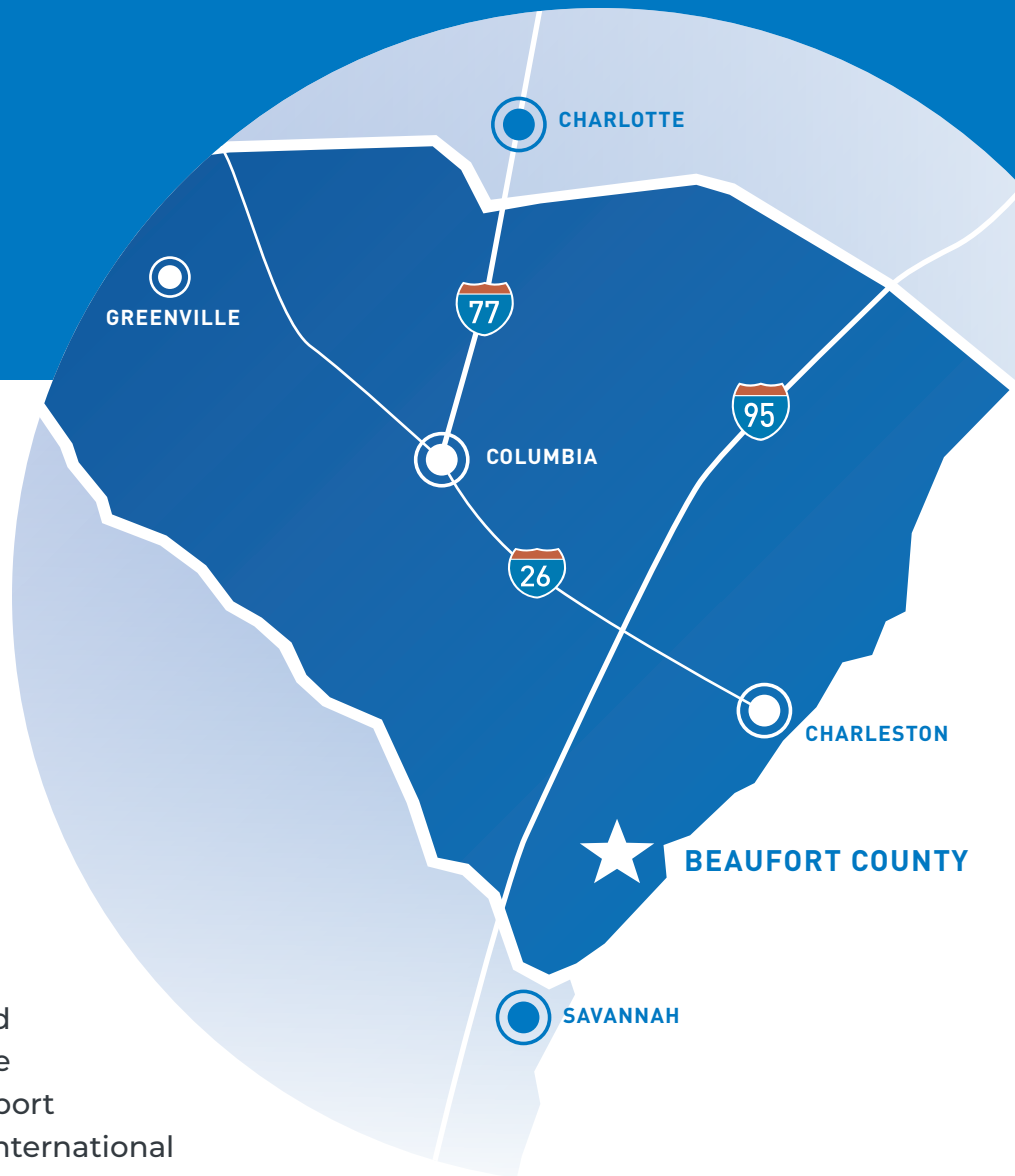
Access

Located in the coastal Lowcountry region of South Carolina along I-95, Beaufort County is comprised of the towns of Hilton Head Island, Bluffton, Port Royal and the City of Beaufort.

It is home to the Hilton Head Island Airport (HHH), and easily accessible to the Charleston International Airport (CHS), the Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport (SAV), the Port of Charleston, and the Port of Savannah. Beaufort County is in the middle of one of the fastest growing manufacturing and distribution areas in the nation.

Beaufort offers proximity to two booming aerospace hubs surrounding the Boeing Dreamliner facility in Charleston and the Gulfstream facility in Savannah, which are attracting aerospace suppliers and advanced manufacturing companies from around the world.

Many successful industries enjoy low operation costs, a business-friendly environment and access to domestic and international markets. Beaufort County is also home to the Marine Corp Air Station and the Marine Corps Recruit Depot on Parris Island. Each year over 900 retiring military personnel exit through Beaufort County, providing a built-in workforce with the skills and leadership growing businesses are looking for. Beaufort County's industrial properties are located within 45 to 65 minutes of two major seaports, the Ports of Charleston, SC and Savannah, GA.



Incentives

Economic development incentives at the state and local level are designed to attract and retain businesses, stimulate investment, and foster job creation within a community.

These incentives can take various forms, such as tax credits, grants, infrastructure improvements, and workforce development programs. Beaufort County Economic Development Corporation collaborates with state agencies to tailor these incentives to meet the specific needs of businesses considering expansion or relocation. WORKFORCE IS THE KEY — AMERICA'S BEST

Beaufort County is Home to 3 Military Bases:



Issue

The single most important issue in today's economy is the availability of a skilled workforce.

Solution

Today, Beaufort County has an answer for investors who wonder where the future workforce will come from. Every year over 900 men and women exit the military through Beaufort County. This game-changing data is lost in most conventional data resources. In addition to tax credits, employers in Beaufort County benefit by having employees who show up to work on time and can pass both drug and background checks.

We have built the Fidelis Employment Program to deliver men and women from the bases in our county to drive continued growth of our region and state's economy. We do this by identifying open positions in South Carolina, working closely with the Transition Assistance Programs on base to entice military personnel to stay in our state, providing training for open positions (through ReadySC and ApprenticeshipCarolina), and getting them hired. Utilizing every means known, we communicate to Beaufort County military personnel a warm sincere Lowcountry welcome. Working with the Technical College of the Lowcountry (TCL) and the University of South Carolina Beaufort (USCB), we show them how to get from there (bases) to here (meaningful employment and housing in SC).

Presently, we have 1,300+ military and/or dependents in programs at USCB or TCL. Data shows that more than 90% of these participants stay in the area.

Resources

How We Measure Success

We track the number of transitioning and retiring military identified and placed.

Tactical Consideration

- A massive Lowcountry welcome! Sharing/promoting quality of life.
- Reduce the barriers to entry – hold participants' hand from training through to employment.
- Boot Camp: Focused, intense training for a short period of time that prepares the participant for the specific needs of targeted employers (i.e.: automotive, aerospace, logistics, etc).
- Placement: Directly aligned with industry's needs, 100% success.

DOD SkillBridge

The DoD SkillBridge program helps transitioning service members gain hands-on civilian work experience through industry training, apprenticeships, or internships during their final 180 days of service. It connects service members with approved industry partners for real-world, full-time training while participants continue to receive their military pay and benefits. SkillBridge benefits service members by easing the transition to civilian careers, supports commanders in preparing their personnel for life after service, and provides industry partners access to a highly skilled, motivated workforce at no cost while evaluating potential future employees.

Biomedical Science

The Biology program at USCB is designed to provide students with comprehensive exposure to the biological sciences at the molecular, physiological, organismal, and ecological levels and prepare them to contribute to the extension of scientific thought and knowledge. Concentration in Biomedical Sciences prepares student for a wide range of technical and professional opportunities in biomedical research or professional schools. Students gain hands-on experience in molecular, cellular, biochemical, and developmental biology and their associated biotechnologies. The types of classes students will take include Neurobiology, Developmental Biology, Histology, Bacteriology, General Physiology, Biological Research methods, Molecular Marine Ecology, and selected Topics in Biology.

Nursing

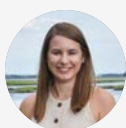
The nursing program at USCB offers a traditional pre-licensure BSN program that requires 121 credits to complete. Upon completion of the BSN, graduates are prepared to take NCLEX-RN and seek licensure. Graduates work in a variety of settings including hospitals, public and community health settings, long term care and more. They make a difference in the lives of the people of South Carolina and beyond one day at a time. Approximately 40 students graduate from the USCB BSN program each May. The program is competitive and small cohorts allow for individualized attention.

Health Science Program

TCL offers Associate Degrees in Surgical Technology, Radiologic Technology, Nursing (ADN), and Physical Therapy. Along with these Associate Degree programs, TCL also offers certifications in Practical Nursing and Medical Assisting. All programs are accredited.

Beaufort County Computer Science & Cyber Security Education Pipeline



B.S. in Computational Science (CSCI)

The B.S. in Computational Science at USCB is specially designed to introduce students to cutting-edge computational and quantitative skills relevant to their concentration or interests. Students who complete the Bachelor of Science in Computational Science can: 1) Develop scientific programs in a high-level language such as Java, C/C++, or Python; 2) Apply critical thinking skills to develop computer simulations and models; 3) Identify and apply methods to efficiently manage data across disciplines; and 4) Work fluently with concepts such as numerical methods and computing techniques/theories to solve problems in an application area.

B.S. in Information Science & Technology (ISAT) with Concentration in Cybersecurity

The Information Sciences and Technology (ISAT) Bachelor of Science degree program with a Concentration in Cybersecurity is designed to educate and train students for careers in technical areas related to the field of cybersecurity. The additional cybersecurity skills conferred by this degree program complement those of the ISAT major, including project management, programming, entrepreneurial thinking, social understanding, and application development. ISAT majors pursuing the Concentration in Cybersecurity will take specialized courses in information security, digital forensics, ethical hacking, and other cybersecurity topics, in addition to courses in system administration, project management, and other topics that will enable them to become cybersecurity specialists and leaders in the information technology (I.T.) field.

B.S. in Information Science & Technology

The general version of the Information Sciences and Technology (ISAT) Bachelor of Science degree program helps organizations achieve strategic goals by bridging technology solutions with user requirements. This includes skill sets in project management, programming, entrepreneurial thinking, social understanding, and application development.

M.S. in Computational Science (CSCI)

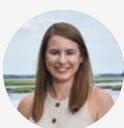

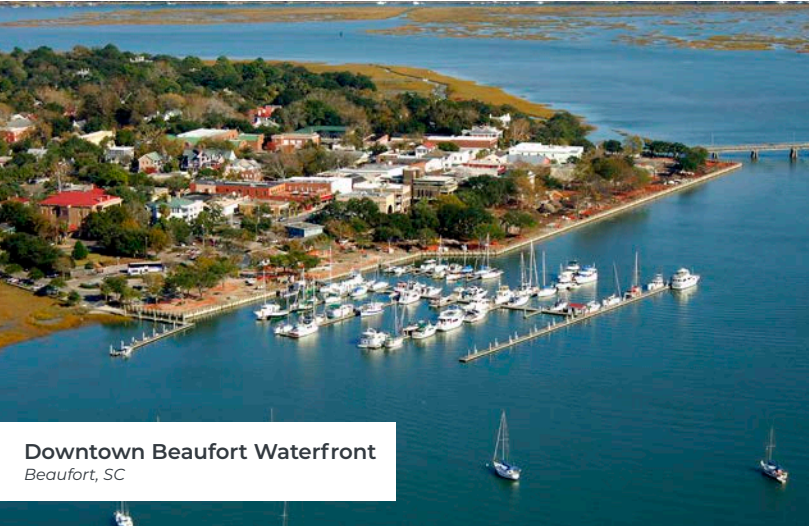
